FORAGE SORGHUM – EVERLUSH

HIGHLY PALATABLE ULTRA LATE FLOWERING FORAGE SORGHUM

Everlush will not initiate flowering until daylight hours are less than 12 hours, 20 minutes This means that you have a bigger window in which grazing or cutting for hay can occur before feed quality starts to fall as flowering is triggered.
